**Beware of "spoof e-mail" using our company name offering a business opportunity  
(Second report)**

As we announced on February 10th, a number of spoof e-mails have been sent in and around USA and Canada, offering a business opportunity using our company's, president's and non-existing executive's name. In addition to that, we newly found out that there are e-mails from that pretending to be our recruit consultant. However, **they absolutely have NO connection to us, Sumitomo Heavy Industries Construction Cranes Co., Ltd.**

Many spoof e-mails have been sent from "Hideo Satoyuki", using a domain "@hsc--cranes.com" and recently, "@outlook.com" is also used. Our company's web-domain is "hsc-cranes.com": apparently number of hyphen (-) differs. If you received a suspicious e-mail like this, please do not react to it.
